## **International Students**

### **Transfer to South Florida Bible College**

South Florida Bible College welcomes students from all countries of the world. Our application deadlines for international students are as follows:

June 1	Fall Term
October 15	Spring Term
March 1	Summer Term

In compliance with U. S. Immigration law please return all the items listed below on or before the registration deadlines. **As International Students we must receive original copies of everything.**

After you complete your work at your present school, you have 60 days to apply to our school for transfer.

Please follow the following steps:

1. [Complete Online Application](#)
  - a. [Including Signed Forms](#)
  - b. School transcripts must be translated in English
2. \$US350 application, registration, international student fee. Non-refundable, made payable to South Florida Bible College, paid in \$US, drawn from a US bank or international money order. Your application can not be processed until this fee is paid.
3. Completed [SEVIS Form](#).
4. Official letter from your bank in the US confirming the account and a current bank statement.
5. A Xerox copy of your passport showing expiration date.
6. A Xerox copy of your current I-20.
7. A Xerox copy of your I-94

8. Sponsor Documents:

1. [Certificate of Financial Responsibility](#), signed by both your sponsor and the applicant (you).
2. Personal letter from your sponsor guaranteeing financial support for one year in the amount of \$US22,000.
  - a) If you are going to live with a relative you will only need \$US15,800 along with a letter from the relative guaranteeing your living expenses and a copy of their driver's license.
3. Official letter from the sponsor's bank confirming an account.
4. Current bank statements showing sufficient funds.

9. Completed [Transfer Verification Report](#).

1. Not to be submitted until all required documents (1-8) are submitted.
  - a. SFBC will contact your school to make sure the International Advisor has changed your record in SEVIS; after they have done so we will prepare your I-20 at which time you must sign it in the presence of a school official.

Note: you may not work during your first year, and must take a full load of classes. For undergraduate students, AA or BA degree, a full load is four classes in the fall and spring terms. For graduate students, MA a full load is three classes in the fall and spring terms.
