

LEVEL 1

Grammar - GRM-011

- This course introduces the use of familiar everyday expressions and very basic phrases aimed at some personal daily needs

Reading - REA-012

- An introduction to numbers and counting is the basis for this course.

Writing - WRIT-013

- This course practices reading and speech of the subjects taught in Reading 012 and Speech 014 together.

Speech/Listening - SPE-014

- This course introduces the main language and expressions used for greeting and counting.

LEVEL 2

Grammar - GRM-021

- At this level, Grammar 021, explores people and personalities, enriching the vocabulary.

Reading - REA-022

- This course does an overview of the cities and its names.

Writing - WRIT-023

- This course introduces two more verb tenses such as simple present, simple past, present continuous and more.

Speech/Listening - SPE-024

- This course teaches expressions for paraphrasing and time expressions.

LEVEL 3

Grammar - GRM-031

- This course revises the previous levels, level 1 and level 2, in this skill, continues to work on simple present and continuous, action and non action verbs. Present perfect and present perfect continuous is also practiced in a more profound way, adding the for/since to it. Introduces future forms: present continuous, going to, will/won't.

Reading - REA-032

- This course brings an understanding of the main points of clear input on familiar matters regularly encountered in work, leisure, etc.

Writing - WRIT-033

- In this course equips the student to produce simple connected text on topics which are familiar or of personal interest.

Speech/Listening - SPE-034

- This course enables the student to describe experiences and events, dreams, hopes and ambitions and briefly express/speak reasons and explanations for opinions and plans.

LEVEL 4

Grammar - GRM-041

- This course continues to build verbal conjugations over the foundation taught in previous levels. In order to succeed in this course student must show the ability to use verb tenses learned in previous levels.

Reading - REA-042

- In this course, students can typically understand the main ideas of complex text on both concrete and abstract topics, including technical discussions in his/her field of specialization.

Writing - WRIT-043

- This course enables the student to produce, clear, detailed text on a wide range of subjects and explain a viewpoint on a topical issue giving the advantages and disadvantages of various options.

Speech/Listening - SPE-044

- This course promotes interacting with a degree of fluency and spontaneity that makes regular interaction with native speakers quite possible without strain for either party
