Worldcat: If you cannot find what you are looking for in our library, the library at Knox Theological Seminary would be an excellent next step. If you cannot find the materials you are looking for in our catalog or any of the reciprocal libraries you can always find books and articles through WorldCat: <http://www.worldcat.org/>

Go to the Worldcat hyperlink and in the upper right hand corner is "create a free account" and register with your name and Email address. The screen will then prompt you to fill out a simple form. Make sure you include country, state and zip code information along with your name and Email address. Worldcat will then help you locate any materials at local libraries and will give you driving distance from your home to each library.

JSTOR:

Is an acronym for Journal Storage and is a system whereby academic journals can be accessed. Subscribing Colleges and Universities can access the on-line full-text searches of journals dating back hundreds of years.
