PROGRAM OVERVIEW

SFBC&TS's Associate's degree in Ministry and Leadership is designed to help you uncover how God has gifted you to lead in your local church and community. Through this degree, you will enhance your leadership and administrative skills and explore foundational topics in religious studies so you can gain an understanding of the biblical and ministerial principles you need to pursue ministry as a profession.

With a degree in Ministry and Leadership, you will gain a strong theological foundation on which you can develop and build your leadership and management philosophy. You will also study the most effective ways to set goals, create collaboration between members of a church staff, develop strategies, and manage the priorities and needs of your organization. Ultimately, you will be better prepared to serve as a pastor, administrator, program director, or Christian leader.

The Associate of Arts degree is awarded to students who have completed a minimum of sixty credit hours of study or its equivalent in the area of ministry/leadership. This degree usually marks the halfway point to the baccalaureate degree.

FORMAT + SCHEDULE

The 60-credit curriculum of the A.A. in Ministry and Leadership program consists of 20 courses which build upon each other to achieve the program objectives.
